For the month ending 05/31/09, our income totaled \$7,924.76 and disbursements totaled \$7,127.98.

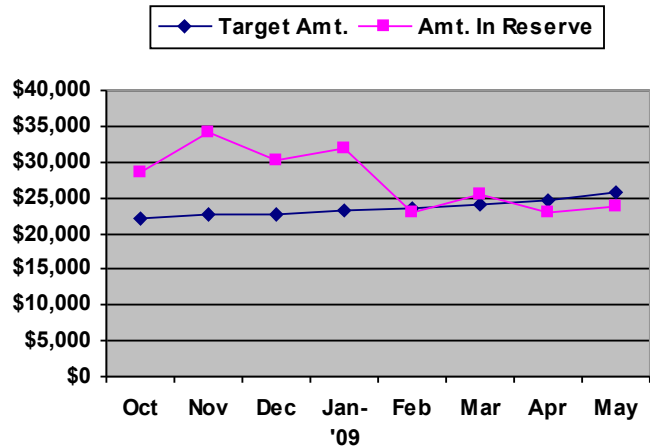
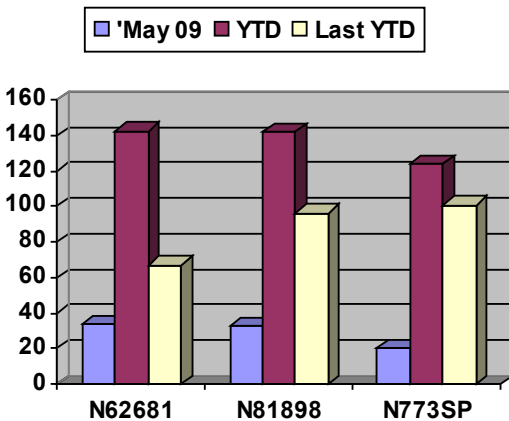
Total Cash on hand is \$23,762.96
